The Venue for Parish Council meetings changed from Congham Hall, whom we thanked for their years of generous hospitality, to the Anvil, St. Andrews Lane.

Work has been ongoing to investigate the restoration of a footpath onto the official map. An Investigation also continues to clarify the status of an historical Fuel Allotment.

A Covid Commemoration Plaque has been installed on the fence at the bottom of Church Walk Grimston Cricket Club has been successful in bids from the Borough Council's Community Infrastructure fund, with the most recent being an astroturf cricket pitch.
